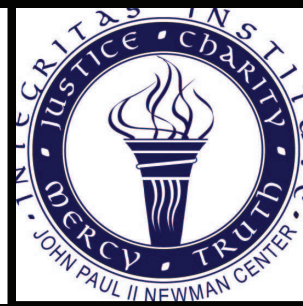

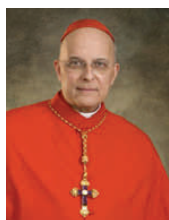
Many Minds One Idea

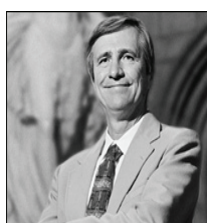

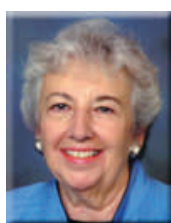
